Cognitive impairment Altered hormone balance Hallucinations

Matthew 4

12 When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He withdrew to Galilee. 13 Leaving Nazareth, He went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun

and Naphtali - 14 to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah:

15 "Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the Way of the Sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles - 16 the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned."

John 8

12 When Jesus spoke again to the people, He said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

1. The world is dark – deeply dark

We are those people living in darkness

Both <u>evil</u> and <u>ignorant</u> – utterly broken and incapable of fixing ourselves

You can't have "delight" without "light"

3. We have this Light (Life, Truth and Beauty) because ...

A. To us, a child is <u>born</u> – v.6

B. To us, a son is given – v.6

"Given" necessitates a decision about receiving or not

Receiving Jesus as your "Light" means admitting you need Him and can't produce the light you need yourself.

Receiving Jesus as your Savior means admitting you need saving.

Receiving Jesus means admitting I need Jesus to know and understand Truth.

Receiving Jesus means admitting I cannot generate true and lasting hope or joy for myself.

John 3

19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their

deeds will be exposed. 21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

Christmas means Light has arrived and is available

It is possible to reject the Sun – to devastating affect.

It's easier to reject the Son – to a more devastating affect.

John 3:18

"Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son."

1 John 5:12

"Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life."

"Thank you God for sending Jesus, Your Son. I need You Lord Jesus to give me eternal life and forgive me of my sins. Please come into my life as the Leader and Source of my life – I am putting my trust in you right now – thank you for shining on and in me."

Radical trust dare –

When you find yourself in a deeply dark place of hopelessness and despair – pain and confusion ... a real crisis of faith ...

Pray – "God I am going to trust You are good even though I don't see it clearly right now. I know in You I have hope even though everything feels hopeless right now. I believe in You, the sun of joy will again rise for me. ...

... I'm going to just hang on to You until it does, and I'm asking You to keep hanging on to me – I am trusting You."
